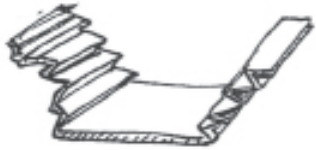
(Christmas Tree Paper Candy)



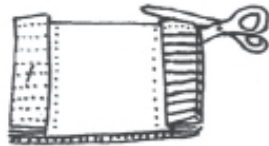
1 Cut into squares, roll into cylinders. Fill with candy.



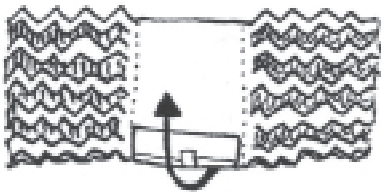
2 Cut tissue paper and place cylinder in the middle. Mark the edges of cylinder and draw lines.



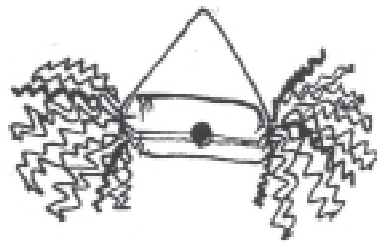
3 Make accordion pleats on each end up to the roll line.

5 Roll the cylinder inside the tissue paper and fasten with a sticker.

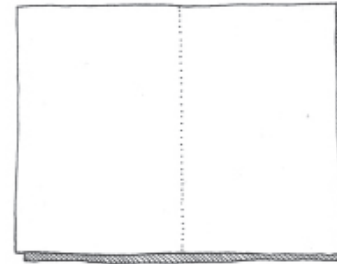


6 Tie a piece of yarn to the ends for hanging.

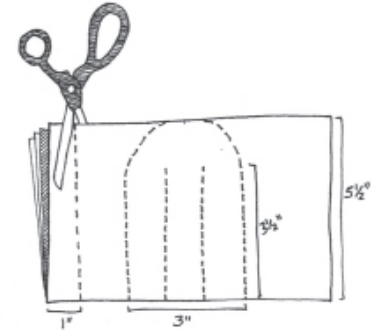

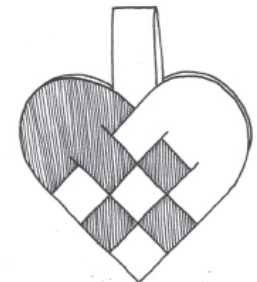
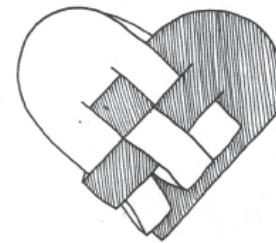
1 Take two sheets of paper
Fold in half



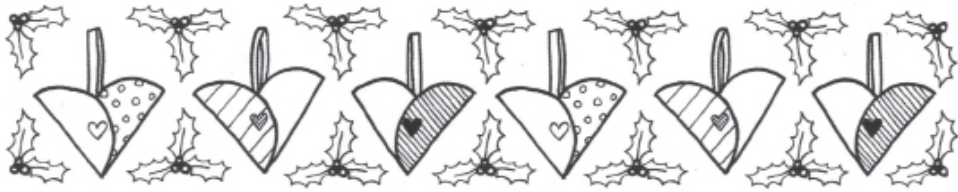
2 Cut the handle

3 Weave together

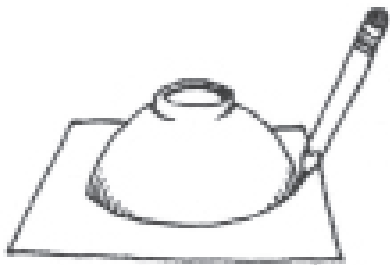

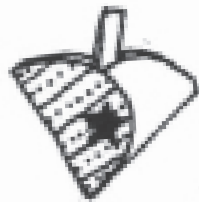
1 Trace 2 circles in different colors

Add a handle

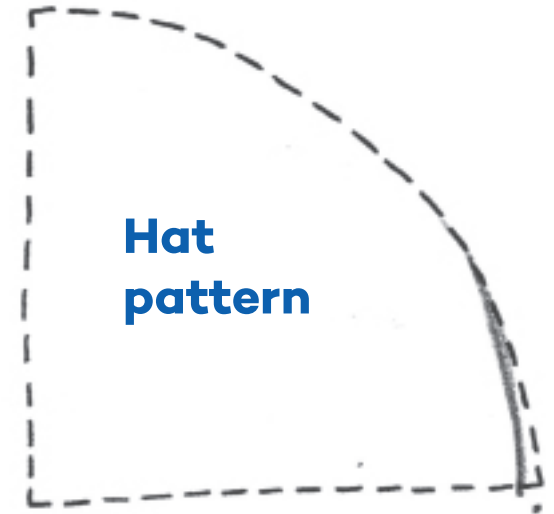

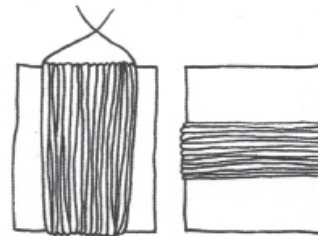
Yarn Tonttu

Supplies

Cardboard: 4½" x 5½"
Yarn: red, grey, or other
Red felt or fabric for hat
Wooden bead: 1" diameter
Cotton for beard
Craft glue, needle, scissors

pattern**

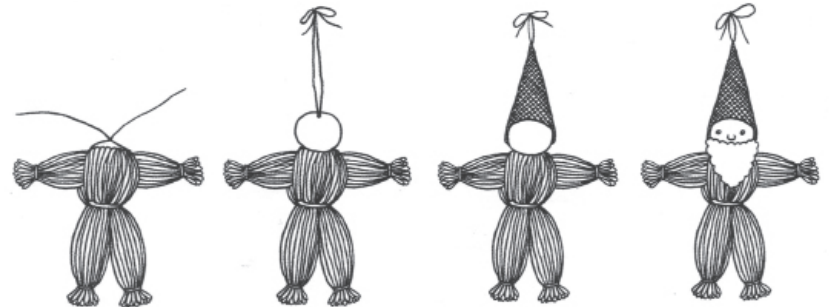


Body

Wrap yarn around tall side of cardboard 20-40 times. Slide yarn off cardboard.

Arms

Wrap yarn around short side of cardboard 10-20 times. Slide yarn off cardboard and insert into body loop. Wrap a string of yarn around the waist.



Tie yarn around
arms and legs and
cut off the loops.

Using a needle, pull
the yard on top
through the bead.

Cut out the hat
using pattern above.
Glue edges to form
a cone. Thread the
yarn through the tip
of the cone, glue the
hat to the head.

Paint a face with
permanent marker
and glue a beard on
your tonttu.
